To accompany this certificate, each outstanding student receives this Honorary Alpha Beta Kappa Gold Key. Professionally diestruck, sandblasted and polished, each Gold Key bears the Greek letters A.B.K., a five-pointed star, laurel branches, and two of the finest words in any language – "Integrity" and "Excellence."

Each honor student also receives a special congratulatory letter from Alpha Beta Kappa, a narrative that describes the society, and upon request a letter of reference to use when seeking employment or other opportunities.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

Student candidates must meet three required criteria as set by Athena Career Academy. General qualifications for regular membership are excellence in the classroom and laboratory work; leadership and service in class and school activities; and personal integrity and good moral character.
